

2018 Friday Night Team Evangelism Ministry Expectations

Two Step Discipleship Process

Each week can be unpredictable as to how many experienced and inexperienced people will attend. We will do our best to pair those who are inexperienced with those who are experienced.

1. Observer – Evangelism can be intimidating. When done as a team it can be less intimidating. For the first few times when you come out to our Friday Night Team Evangelism you are encouraged to observe more experienced Christians and hand out tracts as you're comfortable. This gives you the opportunity to ask questions, learn from others, and grow in comfort with the environment.

2. Participant – After you've spent some time observing, you're encouraged to participate. Within the Body of Christ there are diverse personalities. So, during Friday Night Team Evangelism we have diverse ways to participate in sharing the Gospel. These include: praying, handing out tracts, holding our onlyjesus.ca sign, having conversations, protecting the open-air preacher, and open-air preaching (process required).

Unity

During Friday Night Team Evangelism, we will be giving out our jesus.hbcwr.ca and onlyjesus.ca blue and orange tracts. We will also be giving out Bible's and using our onlyjesus.ca sign. **No other tracts, signs, or literature are permitted.**

People can get very hostile when hearing the Gospel because they are hostile toward God (Rom.8:7). This can be discomfoting for some Christians. It is important to maintain unity in our speech, so when in doubt turn to a more experienced team member for support.

Submission

This is a ministry that is under the local church. The local church is led by elders who've directed a ministry staff (Taylor Lakatos, Director of Evangelism) to oversee this particular ministry. Within the ministry there are multiple lay leaders who lead team evangelism nights. This order is meant to protect the integrity of the Gospel. It is important to submit to the direction of the leadership and ask questions with humility. This also means that all media or police must be directed to leadership. **ONLY elders, ministry staff, and evangelism ministry leaders of the church can converse with police or media.**

If you do not regularly attend Trinity Bible Chapel and desire to regularly participate in the ministry (more than two times), then you are expected to do the following:

- Have a phone interview with Director of Evangelism, Taylor Lakatos
- Answer doctrinal and character questions provided by Trinity Bible Chapel
- Provide two references (one from your pastor which indicates you are a member in good standing within your church, and another reference that testifies to your godly character)
- Sign evangelism ministry expectations and waiver

I understand the expectations listed above for Friday Night Team Evangelism at Trinity Bible Chapel. If I have any questions about the above expectations, how the ministry is led, methods used in sharing Christ, etc. I will ask the leadership with a humble attitude, at an appropriate time, and in a manner that seeks to submit to the Scriptures and leads to Gospel unity.
