Romans Chapters 8-11

(Discussion May 5 for Senior High and May 6 for Junior High)

1. What is the difference between those who live by the flesh and live by the Spirit? Use Scripture to support your answer. Do you live by the flesh or live by the Spirit? How do you know whether you live by the flesh or live by the Spirit?

2. What does Romans 9 teach us about God's justice, mercy, and election? Why is this important? How does human responsibility apply? Use Scripture to support your answer.

3. Explain the difference between the righteousness based on law and the righteousness based on faith as described in Romans 10. Who can receive this righteousness based on faith? How does this impact how we reach out to people? Use Scripture to support your answer.

4. What is Paul arguing in Romans 9-11? How does his argument show us the importance of the Old Testament for our Christian faith? Use Scripture to support your answer.
