**Group Discussion Questions**

3. How would you define humility according to this passage? What are some other Scriptures that speak about humility and what do they teach us about it?
4. Where else in Scripture does it talk about the Lord’s mighty hand? What do we learn from these passages?
5. If humility in suffering involves submitting to the suffering, then what does a prideful response to suffering look like?
6. What does it look like to cast our anxieties on to the Lord? What are some idols that we can be tempted to cast our anxieties onto or rely too much on during times of suffering?
7. What is the motivation behind humbling yourself that’s given in this passage? What does God promise for those who humble themselves?
8. What is the promise of exaltation grounded in? How does that comfort you?
