**Group Discussion Questions**

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the sermon and the Bible study this week?
2. How can it be said that “familiarity with the things of God could be deadly for some on the day of judgment”?
3. The Pharisees asked for a sign in verse 38. Why? How do we know this was an insincere request?
4. The Pharisees have Christ here standing in front of them in the flesh, performing miracles and yet they still don’t believe. Why? How is it that someone can witness the miracles of Christ and still not believe? What does this teach us about unbelieving hearts and about the nature of salvation?
5. How does Jesus rebuke the Pharisees in verse 39?
6. Does Jesus promise a sign? What is the sign?
7. Compare the Ninevites to the Pharisees in terms of their familiarity with the things of God. Which group has more light? Why?
8. Compare the Queen of Sheba to the Pharisees in terms of familiarity with the things of God. Who had more light? Why?
9. What does it mean that Jesus is the greater Jonah (v. 41)? The greater Solomon (v. 42)? What must our response to these truths be?
