2. How would you define “idolatry”? What are some examples of prevalent idols in our culture today?
3. What sorts of idols do you think Christians today are more prone to struggle with? Why?
4. Why does God choose weak men like Gideon to use for his glory? Why didn’t he choose the strongest man in Israel?
5. How can we find motivation to obey God, even when we know that it will cost us? Why do we owe God our obedience no matter what?
6. When obedience to God comes at a cost, how can we find strength, safety, and hope in the sovereignty of God?
7. How does God show his protection, patience, and grace to Gideon in the passage? How does this encourage you as you consider your own trials and fears?
8. If there an idol in your life that God is calling you to tear down? How will you seek to do this?
9. How is Jesus the “better Gideon”? Why is he and he alone deserving of our praise and worship?
