### Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. Who do you believe the intended audience is for this parable? Why?
3. Explain the parable. What does the wedding feast represent? How is the king? Who is the son? Who are the servants? Who are the guests? What is the significance of it being a 'feast'?
4. Describe the different kinds of people that reject the king's invitation to come to the wedding feast. What are some of the main reasons that people reject the gospel?
5. How does the king react to the mistreatment of his servants? What does this teach us about God's love for his servants and how serious of an injustice it is to mistreat them?
6. Among those that receive invitations in verse 10, are those "both good and bad". What does it mean that there are "both good and bad" at the wedding feast?
7. What implications does this parable have for our evangelism? Who is the offer of the gospel for?
8. What is the wedding garment? Why is it needed? How do we acquire it? What happens to those without it?
9. How do we practically apply this parable to our lives?
