**Group Discussion Questions**

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the sermon and the Bible passage this week?
2. What promise did God make to Abraham? How does his promise now extend to us in Christ? Explain.
3. How is our trust in God’s word and his promises tied to his unchangeable character?
4. How do we know that God’s Word is sure? If someone was doubting the certainty of God’s promises to us, how would you reassure them?
5. What is the purpose of an oath? Why did God decide to swear an oath to Abraham? See Hebrews 6:17-18, Genesis 22:16-18.
6. What is the ‘hope’ that the author of Hebrews is referring to in verse 19? Explain.
7. What does it mean that Jesus is our ‘forerunner’? What has he secured for us as our forerunner?
8. Why does our soul need an anchor? If it’s anchored to anything other than Jesus Christ, what will happen? Why?
9. How do we practically “hold fast to the hope set before us,” (v. 18)? What does it look like to anchor our souls to Jesus, especially in the storms of this life?
