3. Explain why God himself is the biggest problem for those outside of Christ. How can we have his anger turned away?
4. How does regularly remembering what we’ve been saved *from* help cultivate thankfulness in our lives?
5. How is the individual in verse 2 able to say, “I will trust and will not be afraid”? How is a greater trust in the Lord and antidote to our fear?
6. What would you say to encourage a Christian toward joyful praise whose circumstances are causing them to be discouraged and disheartened? How can we rejoice even in the midst of such hardship?
7. How are worship and evangelism related?
8. How does our corporate worship impact our public witness? What do our times of corporate worship communicate to the world about Jesus Christ?
