Group Discussion Questions

- 1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
- 2. What indicators are there in the text that can lead us to conclude that Jesus is moving on to a new topic?
- 3. Jesus repeats the idea several times in this text that we do not know when he will come. Why is this significant? What is Jesus emphasizing in repeating himself on this matter?
- 4. Verse 36 indicates that the Son does not even know when his return will be. What do we do with a verse like this given that we believe in the deity of Christ?
- 5. Jesus compares the times surrounding his 2nd coming with the times of Noah. How are these times alike?
- 6. Why is it often easier to live with a sense of urgency during tumultuous times than during easy times? How can we cultivate a sense of urgency in our lives during times of comfort and normalcy?
- 7. What does it mean to "be ready" for Christ's return? How can we live as people who are "ready"?
- 8. How does living in light of *that day* impact our burden for the lost around us? How should we interact with loved ones in our lives that are not currently ready?
