Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. What is the context/occasion of our passage today? Why is this important?
3. Read Exodus 12 and briefly summarize the Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread.
4. How is the Passover fulfilled in Jesus? How is the Passover linked to the Lord's Supper?
5. How did the disciples show meekness in their desire to observe the Passover with Jesus?
6. What is meant by the phrase "My time is at hand," in verse 18?
7. Why did Jesus head to Jerusalem according to this text, despite knowing what it would cost him? What does this teach us about the importance of gathering and properly observing the ordinances no matter the cost?
8. In his time of trial, Jesus desired to be with God's people. In your most trying moments, where do you go? Why is it important to prioritize being with God's people when we go through hardship and trial?
