### Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. Pastor Jacob said, *"The 10 commandments serve as the moral foundation of the New Covenant."* What does this mean? What role do the 10 commandments play in the New Covenant?
3. What would you say to someone who argues that Jesus put an end to the use and authority of the law? How would you use Scripture to support your argument?
4. How are Commandments 5-10 spoken about and reinforced in the New Testament?
5. How are Commandments 1-4 spoken about and reinforced in the New Testament?
6. Read James 2:10-11. What does this passage teach us about the law? If someone sins in one part of the law, why would it be as though they have violated all of it?
7. Read Romans 6:14, Romans 7:4-6, and Galatians 2:19. What do these passages teach us about the law of God? Do they teach that the law has been abrogated? Explain.
8. Why do Christians *want* to obey the law under the New Covenant? If you do not have a desire to obey the law, why ought this to be concerning? Use Scripture to support your answer.
9. As Christians under the New Covenant, how can we seek to better delight (see Psalm 1:2) in keeping God's law?
