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## **Group Discussion Questions**

- 1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
- 2. Pastor Jacob said, "The 10 commandments serve as the moral foundation of the New Covenant." What does this mean? What role do the 10 commandments play in the New Covenant?
- 3. What would you say to someone who argues that Jesus put an end to the use and authority of the law? How would you use Scripture to support your argument?
- 4. How are Commandments 5-10 spoken about and reinforced in the New Testament?
- 5. How are Commandments 1-4 spoken about and reinforced in the New Testament?
- 6. Read James 2:10-11. What does this passage teach us about the law? If someone sins in one part of the law, why would it be as though they have violated all of it?
- 7. Read Romans 6:14, Romans 7:4-6, and Galatians 2:19. What do these passages teach us about the law of God? Do they teach that the law has been abrogated? Explain.
- 8. Why do Christians *want* to obey the law under the New Covenant? If you do not have a desire to obey the law, why ought this to be concerning? Use Scripture to support your answer.
- 9. As Christians under the New Covenant, how can we seek to better delight (see Psalm 1:2) in keeping God's law?
