Sermon: "Our Hope in the Risen Christ" – 1 Corinthians 15:12-19

Date: October 29, 2023

Group Discussion Questions

- 1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
- 2. What is the connection between our future resurrection and the resurrection of Christ? Explain what Paul means in verse 13 when he writes, *"If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised."*
- 3. Why would Paul say that our faith is in *vain* if Christ is not raised (v. 14)?
- 4. In 2 Corinthians 4:4, Paul refers to the gospel as *"the gospel of the glory of Christ."* What does he mean by that? What is the good news of the glory of Christ?
- 5. Read Philippians 3:7-11. What did Paul live for? Explain the value that Paul placed on knowing Christ and the power of his resurrection in this passage.
- 6. How can we assess whether we've come to know and prize the Lord Jesus like the apostle Paul has? In what ways should our lives look drastically different from unbelievers?



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- 7. If our Lord Jesus was still in the grave, what would that imply about Christ's atonement? Why was the resurrection *necessary*? How is it connected to our justification (Romans 4:25)?
- 8. If in this life *only* we have hope in Christ, why are we as Christians a people most to be pitied (v. 19)? If someone were to evaluate the way we spent our time, money, and energy, what would a "pitiable" life look like if Christ is not raised?
- 9. But in fact, Christ has been raised (v. 20)! In summary, why is the resurrection of Christ at the very center of our faith? Why is the resurrection a source of great hope for the Christian? List all the reasons you can come up with.
