Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. What is at the heart of the 6th commandment? What does the 6th commandment require of us? Why?
3. Compare and contrast worldly, superficial ideas and notions of love with true biblical love.
4. If we want to know how to properly love others, why ought we to study God's love? How will studying his love help us to demonstrate godly love to others?
5. Most people would agree with the phrase: "God is love." The problem is that they don't know what that statement actually means. What does it mean that "God is love," (1 John 4:8)? Why can't other monotheistic religions state that their 'god' is love?
6. In what ways does God demonstrate his love for all of mankind? Explain and use Scripture.
7. In what ways does God demonstrate a love that is discriminatory? Explain and use Scripture.



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8. As we seek to love like God, in what ways ought we to show discrimination in our love for others? Explain and use Scripture to support your answer.

9. How does God love his enemies? How ought we to love our enemies? Use Scripture to support your answer.

10. How does God demonstrate his love for his people in Christ? What expressions and benefits of his love are reserved solely for his people? Use Scripture to support your answer.
