Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. Explain the dilemma that we are presented with when we consider the *justice* of God and the *forgiveness* of God. How are these two concepts seemingly at odds with each other?
3. Read Isaiah 5:16. What does it mean for God to be exalted? How do we exalt God?
4. How do displays of God's justice serve to increase our perception and understanding of his glory and greatness? Explain. Use scriptural examples to support your answer.
5. If God had unjust laws or if he had just laws that he didn't enforce, would he be worthy of our exaltation? Explain.
6. Read Romans 3:25-26. How does Christ's work on the cross "*show God's righteousness?*"
7. Verse 26 says that God is just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. What does that mean?
