Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. Who is called to engage in the work of evangelism? What Scriptures would you use to defend your answer?
3. Why is reliance on the Holy Spirit so important as we seek to share the gospel with others? How can we seek to be filled with the Spirit and keep in step with the Spirit? See Galatians 5 among other passages.
4. The Holy Spirit guided and directed Philip throughout this entire conversation. Describe a time where you felt prompted by the Holy Spirit to strike up a gospel conversation with someone else. How did you respond to the Spirit's prompting?
5. Philip witnessed to the Ethiopian Eunuch despite his social, cultural, and ethnic differences. Why is it so important that we be impartial in our witness to others? How is partiality in evangelism antithetical to the gospel and the Great Commission?
6. Philip uses Scripture to share the good news of Jesus with the eunuch. Why ought we to be reliant on Scripture when sharing the gospel?



7. What are some Scriptures you would use to share the gospel from? How would you share the gospel using these Scriptures?

8. In evangelism, why is it important to steer the conversation toward Jesus Christ? What are some ways in which we can do this?

9. Why is it necessary to press someone toward a response after you've shared the gospel with them? Give examples from Scripture where others have done this.

10. What do we learn about baptism from verses 36-38?

11. How can we better cultivate the spiritual discipline of evangelism in our life? What are some things we can do to grow and persevere in this area?
