



Sermon: “Choose This Day” – Joshua 24:14-28

Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. What is the greater context of this chapter? Where are we at in salvation-history?
3. Before Joshua issues his charge to the people to choose whom they will serve, he recounts the good deeds of the Lord in the earlier part of this chapter (see verses 1-13). What great things does he recount? Why does he make a point of recounting the Lord’s good deeds? Why is it important to remember the good things that God has done for his people and for us?
4. What charge does Joshua give the people in verses 14-15? Explain what he is ultimately demanding of the people.
5. What does it look like to *exclusively* follow and serve the Lord as an individual and as a household?
6. How do the people respond in verses 16-18 to Joshua’s charge?
7. Verse 19 seems at odds with what Joshua said earlier in verses 14-15. Why does Joshua say what he does in verse 19?

8. What does idolatry and friendship with the world lead to according to verse 20?

9. Commenting on the public nature of Joshua's commitment to the Lord, Pastor Randy said, "*Faith with the Lord is more than what you do in your home.*" How is serving the Lord a *public* endeavour? In what ways is our service to the Lord public?

10. Read Judges 2:10-11. How did Israel end up here? What was the failure of Joshua's generation that led to the times of the judges?

11. How can we ensure that we serve the Lord *generationally*? How can we practically ensure that we are passing on the faith to the next generation and guiding our households to serve the Lord?
