Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. Pastor Jacob has stated that he chose to preach through Daniel because it offers a message of great hope for the expansion of God's Kingdom. Please explain how this unfolded throughout Daniel. Why should this give us hope in the midst of our troubled times?
3. How did Jesus apply the prophecy in Daniel 12:1? How did this prophecy unfold in history?
4. The messenger who gave Daniel the prophecy in chapter 11 and 12 did not give a clear answer when asked when these things would happen. Why should we as Christians be comfortable with this unknown?
5. Define faith using Scripture. How does this apply with regards to Christians living without full knowledge of God's plans?
6. Explain the significance of the final verse in Daniel being one of rest and triumph for Daniel after the destruction of the statue, the beasts, and centuries of grim times for Israel. What lesson(s) can we take from this?
7. How should the reality of eternal, conscious torment in Hell motivate unbelievers to repentance and faith? How ought this to motivate our own perseverance?

8. How should the eternal beauty, triumph, and glory promised to those found in Christ affect our daily walk?

9. Daniel 12:10 tells us that the righteous will grow in righteousness, and the wicked will persist in their wickedness. What does this teach us about perseverance in the face of evil?
