Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. Pastor Jacob mentioned that we need to read and understand chapter 11 in light of what we just studied in chapter 10, as well as in light of previous prophecies found in earlier chapters of Daniel. Why is this important?
3. Explain the idiom used in verse 2. Use other Scripture to help support your answer.
4. Briefly summarize the sequence of events that unfold in verse 2-20. Have these events been fulfilled? Explain.
5. Put yourself in the shoes of an Israelite that had received these prophecies and now you're watching them all unfold before your eyes. How might their fulfillment, despite all that chaos and bloodshed all around you, serve as a great comfort and source of confidence?
6. How do the rulers of the earth serve as God's "pawns on a chessboard" so-to-speak? How does this reality benefit the believer?
7. Without acknowledging the sovereignty of God, how would we deal with all the chaos of this world? How do unbelievers around us deal with it?

8. To what purpose(s) and to what end does God sovereignly orchestrate the events of our lives and of all human history? Use Scripture to support your answer.

9. Are there any situations in our nation or on the world scene that temps you toward anxiety and despair? Explain. As a Christian, how can you battle against these temptations?
