Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. What were the 4 main points of Pastor Randy's sermon?
3. Why did Saul think that he was serving God by persecuting Christians? What are some modern-day examples of this?
4. Pastor Randy taught that all Christians were once enemies of God like Saul. What are some applications of this truth for Christians?
5. Why should the fact that Jesus identifies with his church be comforting to you as you face persecution for your faith?
6. What was Saul's response to Jesus' confronting him with his sin? How should you respond when your sin is exposed?
7. Why is it important that you confront the sin in unbelievers when sharing the gospel with them?



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8. Saul endured great suffering to fulfill God's calling on his life (2 Cor. 11:23–27). What should this teach you about God's purpose for your life?

9. How should you treat someone who once was your enemy but has since come to salvation? Please use Scripture to support your answer.

10. How has your salvation changed you? Think in terms of beliefs, actions, appetites/desires, values, and more.
