Group Discussion Questions

1. How did the Holy Spirit speak to you through the teaching and bible passage this week?
2. What were the 5 main points of this sermon?
3. How does Jehoshaphat’s life show that crises in your life are not necessarily a result of your sin?
4. Why should fasting be an important part of your Christian disciplines? What are some practical tips to help people to do this?
5. What are some legitimate and illegitimate reasons for missing the Sunday gathering? What does missing church for illegitimate reasons reveal about someone’s heart?



6. Jehoshaphat's prayer included other Old Testament references and language. Why should we pray God's Word back to Him?

7. Why should Christians today still pray for judgement of God's enemies?

8. How did the Israelites prepare to meet the enemy armies? Why is singing and worship the right thing to do in a crisis?

9. How would you counsel someone in crisis now? How should those not in crisis now prepare for a crisis?

10. What is the connection that Pastor Randy pointed out between this story and the gospel?
